
DLTC Bar Committee Report - 2017

There was an increase in both sales and profit in 2017. Sales were up £1569 from £12,957 in 2016 to £14,526 and the gross profit was up £643 from £7183 in 2016 to £8001. The gross profit ratio achieved was maintained at about 55%. General bar takings and club functions evenings have shown increased sales. The major contributor to the bar sales and profit continues to be the private hire events.
