Coaches Tip of the Month

How can I avoid being lobbed when I come into the net?

Generally speaking, your opponent will cause more damage with the lob if they have a good opportunity to execute it well. The quality of your approach shot (or serve) could deny them of that opportunity. Put one or more of the following ingredients into your approach shots (or serves):

- 1. hit deep
- 2. get your opponent off-balance
- 3. serve at the body to 'jam' your opponent
- 4. use slice to keep the ball low
- 5. aim at your opponent's weaker wing
